Expectations for Use:

1. Use the device for educational purposes only.
2. Keep food and beverages away from the Chromebook or Tablet
3. Use the provided carrying case for protection.
4. Keep the device safe and in your control while on and off campus.
5. Report any problems, damage or missing keys immediately to your teacher.
6. Return the Chromebook or Tablet, power cable and carrying case annually or when disenrolling from the District school.
7. Damage incurred while using the Chromebook or Tablet may result in repairs or replacement. Arrangements will be made according to each individual situation and circumstance and depending on the severity. You may be asked to pay for repairs or replacement at the cost outlined in the District's Acceptable Use Policy and as listed in the Scott Valley Unified Technology Contract Fee Chart below. Every effort will be made to work with you.
